NOTIFICATION.

In continuation to this Office Notification NO. KMC/NOT-01/2011 Dated Kohima the 16th March, 2013 regarding regulation of Plastic (Waste Management & Handling) Rule,2011 under Kohima Municipal Council jurisdiction, it is hereby notified that during the course of manufacture, stocking, distribution, sale and use of carry bags and sachets, the following should be fulfilled:-

1. Conditions:

(a). As per rules, carry bags should be manufactured in white or made using pigments and colorants which are in conformity with Indian Standards under IS 9833:1981 and recycled carry bags will have to conform to Indian standard IS 14534:1998 and bear a label as a mark "recycled". Carry bags made from compostable plastics should have a label saying "compostable" and conform to the Indian standard IS/150 17088:2088.

(b). No person shall manufacture, stock, distribute or sell any carry bags made of virgin or recycled or compostable plastic which is less than 40 microns in thickness.

(c). Each Plastic carry bags and multi layered packaging shall have the name, registration number of the manufacturer, size, weight and thickness printed on it.

2. Pricing of the plastic bags.

No carry bags shall be made available free of cost by retailers to consumers.
Rates as per size for 40 microns and above have been fixed as below.

<u>Size</u>	<u>Per piece in Rs.</u>
9"x13"	2
13"x16"	3
16"x20"	4
17"x23"	5
20"x26"	6
24"x30"	7

3. Penalties to be Imposed.

Penalties would be awarded to traders who utilize illegal plastic bags. The first offence will cost them Rs 2,500/- to Rs 5,000/-.

Under Labour Act, the next violation, i.e. Second offence would lead to cancellation of the shop's license.

Any firm/stockiest supplying the 40 microns and above plastic will have to get the approval of Kohima Municipal Council. It is also notified that a label print of "KMC approved" Logo will be used on all the materials in order to check the quality and originality of the product in the market.

This will be strictly enforced in the capital city with immediate effect.
